

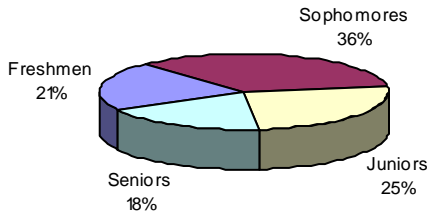

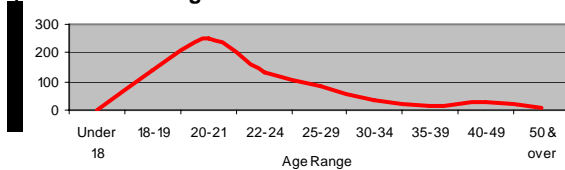

Age of New Transfers



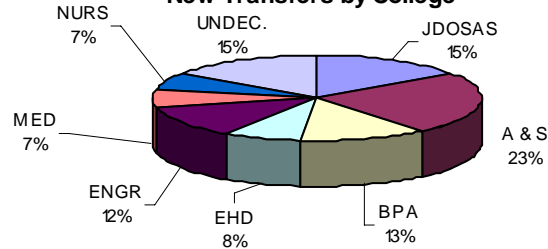
