Tuition and Payment Information. . .

Veterans and their spouse qualify for the North Dakota resident tuition rate.

The University of North Dakota is a participant in the Yellow Ribbon Program and will provide up to \$10,000 of remaining costs per academic year per student. This applies to an unlimited number of eligible Chapter 33 veterans educational benefit recipients in all programs at UND.

We understand that the processing of benefits and other factors can make it difficult to meet tuition and fee payment deadlines the first semester at UND. Veteran students will not be charged a fee for late payment of tuition and fees their first semester at UND. In addition, no late fee will be charged to a student who is using Veterans Educational Benefits to pay tuition and fees.

Located on the second floor of the Memorial Union, the Student Success Center provides academic advising for all students who are in the process of deciding on a major.

Adult Re-Entry Program. . .

Co-located with the **Veteran's Upward Bound Program**. Provides non-credit coursework and support services to prepare for postsecondary education and to facilitate work mobility and advancement.
