**I. UNIVERSITY GRADUATION  
REQUIREMENTS**

- \_\_\_ 125 semester hours of credit.  
(60 hours at four-year institutions, the last 30 hours at UND.)
- \_\_\_ Including 39 hours in General Education.
- \_\_\_ 9 hours in Communication  
**HIST 240** (3 hrs.) counts toward this requirement.
- \_\_\_ 9 hours in Social Sciences
- \_\_\_ 9 hours in Humanities  
**6 hours of History can count as either Social Science or Humanities, but not both.**
- \_\_\_ 12 hours in Mathematics, Science, and Technology
- \_\_\_ 3 hours (in any category) must have "World Cultures" credit

**II. HISTORY DEPARTMENT  
REQUIREMENTS**

Two options are offered for the History major, and each by itself leads to a B.A. with a major in History. Option A is primarily for those who plan to enter professional schools, such as law, and for those who want to pursue advanced work in history at the graduate level. Option B is designed primarily for those who want to enter government service, business, or teaching at the secondary level.

When taken in conjunction with the Teaching and Learning program in Secondary Education, Option B satisfies the requirements for teacher certification in the Social Sciences. Prospective teachers should seek an advisor in the College of Education and Human Development in addition to their advisor in the History department.

    - Hist 103 U S to 1877
    - Hist 104 U S. since 1877
  - \_\_\_ Hist 240 Historian's Craft (3hrs.)
  - \_\_\_ Hist 440 Research. (3 hrs.)
  - \_\_\_ 21 credit hours of Electives
    - 15 must be 300/400 level
- \_\_\_ Level IV proficiency in a foreign language.  
(2 yrs/4 courses)

**Option B**

- \_\_\_ 36 hours in History, including:
  - \_\_\_ All four Surveys (12 hrs.)
    - \_\_\_ Hist 101 West Civ I
    - \_\_\_ Hist 102 West Civ II
    - \_\_\_ Hist 103 U S to 1877
    - \_\_\_ Hist 104 U S. since 1877
  - \_\_\_ Hist 240 Historian's Craft (3hrs.)
  - \_\_\_ Hist 440 Research. (3 hrs.)
  - \_\_\_ 18 credit hours of Electives
    - 15 must be 300/400 level
    - 12 must be **either** US or non-US
- \_\_\_ required in other departments:
  - \_\_\_ ANTH 171 Cultural Anthrop (3hrs.)
  - \_\_\_ ECON 105 Elements of Econ (3hrs.)
  - \_\_\_ ECON 420 Economic Education (3 hrs.)
