 - What scores do I need on future tests and assignments to improve my grades?

- **CONSULT WITH YOUR ADVISOR TO ADDRESS THESE ISSUES:**
 - Am I in the right classes for my major and interests?
 - What are my options for withdrawing from a class at this date?
 - What campus resources can help me improve my grades?
- **VISIT THE CAREER WALK-IN CENTER AND THE CAREER COUNSELING CENTER:** Visit the Career Walk-In Center (McCannel, Rm. 280) and take the Career Lift-Off online interest inventory. Meet with a career counselor at the UND Counseling Center (McCannel, Rm. 200) to talk about what majors best fit your interests.
