Announcements

Bridget reported that the CVIC meetings held in CL 140 on Wednesday evenings are potentially being moved elsewhere. Dr. Weatherly is working on the issue.

Caitlin updated the group regarding the Teaching Track concerns for clinical students. She said the faculty approved clinical students teaching in the department and getting paid, as long as they have good standing and monitor their placement hours.

Approval of last month's minutes is pending until read by members.

Naomi reported that the GRASP account total is \$984.51. Potential options for the money were discussed- purchasing a computer, Dream Weaver software, office software, or SPSS. Mark said the Website Committee will look into pricing computers and programs. There was also discussion of the computer being for only-member use.

Troy discussed GRASP having its own room on the 3rd floor in an old INPSYDE room once the new Behavioral Research building is finished. Caitlin said there may also be empty space on the 4th floor.

Troy brought up that the Workshop Committee may need money as a jump start to their first project. Caitlin mentioned that outside sources may donate money or that the University takes applications for funding.
