Selection Criteria

Proposals will be assessed based on their relevance to the conference theme, topic, content quality, and creativity.

Submission guidelines

1. Proposals must be submitted on the H.E.R.O.S. 2009 Presenter Application Form by **June 30, 2009**.
2. Submit copy electronically using Microsoft Word document to conference coordinator (see application for address).
3. Bios must be submitted describing the presenters along with a personal photo.
4. Presentation must be limited to one hour (60 minutes) or one and a half hours (90 minutes)
5. Please make a copy for your own records.
6. All presenters must register for the conference.

If your proposal is accepted, you will be contacted in early July. At that time you will be kept updated on the number registrations so you can plan accordingly for handouts and materials for your workshop.
